


Host—Wafer that during consecration becomes the Body of Christ



Chalice—Sacred Vessel that contains the wine that transforms into the Blood of Christ

Copoón—Copa grande que se usa para distribuir la Comunión a los fieles
Cup—Large Cup that is used for distribution Communion to the faithful

Paten—Bandeja o plato donde se deposita la Hostia durante la Misa
Paten—Bowl or plate where the Host sits during the Mass
