Sagrario—Lugar donde se guardan las Hostias que fueron Consagradas en la Misa

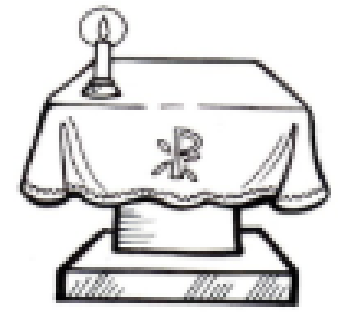
Patén—Bowl or plate where the Host sits during the Mass

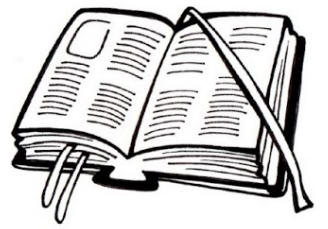
Chalice—Sacred Vessel that contains the wine that transforms into the Blood of Christ
